



Sanotint Hair Dye Classic & Sensitiv

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HOW TO DYE YOUR HAIR

1. Preparation – Natural Coloring with Confidence

Squeeze the contents of the colour tube into a bowl.
Add the fixing emulsion and mix until smooth and creamy.
Put on the supplied gloves.

2. Sectioning the Hair

Divide your hair into four equal sections: from forehead to nape, and from ear to ear. This ensures even application.

3. Applying the Colour

Apply the dye to dry, unwashed hair.
Start at the parting and work from front to back.
Then continue from ear to ear.
Fill in the remaining sections to achieve even coverage.
Use a brush or the special Sanotint applicator for quick, uniform distribution.

4. Processing Time

Cover the hair with foil if desired.
Leave to process for 30–40 minutes.

5. Rinsing & Washing

Rinse thoroughly with warm water.
Then wash with shampoo.

6. Applying the Conditioner

Towel-dry the hair gently.
Apply the revitalising conditioner without rinsing.
Comb through and style as usual.

Warnings

- Do not use hair dye on sensitive, irritated, or damaged scalp.
- If in doubt, perform a sensitivity test 48 hours beforehand.
- Not suitable for eyelashes or eyebrows.
- In case of eye contact: rinse immediately with water.
- Keep out of reach of children.

Tips & Notes

Always wear gloves during the colouring process.
Remove any colour stains on skin or clothing immediately with water.

For retouching:

Roots first: 30 min
Then the rest of the hair: 15 min

Never mix Sanotint Classic with Sanotint Sensitive.

Mixing colours within the Classic or Sensitive line is possible.

For skin conditions such as psoriasis or eczema:
always perform a patch test first.
